If you are considering leaving the Malaghan Institute a gift in your will - thank you!

Depending on your personal situation and preferences for supporting our medical research, we suggest the following wording when making a gift in your will:

“I give to the Malaghan Institute of Medical Research, Charity Reg CC10357

a) All of my residuary estate (OR)

b) _____percentage (%) of my residuary estate (OR)

c) The sum of \$ _____ (OR)

d) [list asset or assets] to be used for the general purposes of medical research by the Institute.

I declare that the receipt of a Director of the Institute or other authorised officer will be a sufficient discharge to my executors.”
